#### INTRODUCTION

The Alcolizer Easy Check (EC) is the personal breath alcohol test unit relied on by thousands to keep safe.

The Alcolizer EC uses the same electrochemical fuel cell sensing technology as used by Australian Police Forces, but comes at an affordable price for personal users.

Whilst the Alcolizer EC utilises police standard electrochemical fuel cell sensing technology, the vast majority of 'personal breath testers' in the market use low cost semi-conductor sensors or cheap, low grade manufactured fuel cells. Alcolizer chooses to exclusively use the highest-grade platinum fuel cells for all of our products, including the Alcolizer EC.

Manufactured to the highest quality standard (ISO:9001) and holding Australian Standard AS 3547 Type 2, the EC is the smart choice for the personal user.

### ALCOHOL BREATH TESTING AND FUEL CELL TECHNOLOGY

Police grade breath testers are designed to monitor the exhaled breath of a subject and analyse a sample of "deep lung air," where the quantity of any alcohol in the blood

is found by the breath moving in and out of the deepest parts of the lungs.

By accurately measuring the blow pressure, high quality breath testers, like the Alcolizer EC, collect a sample of true deep lung air, then accurately analyse any alcohol present in the breath using high grade platinum fuel cell technology. Very few alcohol breath testers meet the stringent standards of accuracy and sensitivity of Australian Police. As the largest manufacturer and supplier to Australian Police, Alcolizer insists on using the same grade of electrochemical fuel cell sensors in all our instruments, including the Alcolizer EC personal breath tester.

Members of the public can test themselves on an Alcolizer EC, knowing that the technology and accuracy is the same as they might be tested on by Police on the roadside.



### MAINTAINING AUSTRALIAN STANDARDS

In order to maintain Australian Standards Certification, the Alcolizer EC must be recalibrated every six months.

All Alcolizer EC's should be returned to Alcolizer in the Express Post envelope supplied with the instrument when "RECAL" appears on the display screen.

Full service and calibration is conducted by highly trained Factory Certified Technicians to ensure that the instrument continues to analyse blood alcohol concentration (BAC) in strict compliance with the Australian Standard AS 3547 Type II.

# THE EASY CHECK BATTERY LIFE

**Please Note:** The Alcolizer EC **does not** require any change of battery between the six-monthly service and recalibration.

The instrument holds a display on the screen in a 'low power mode' (appearing that it hasn't switched off) however this is normal operation. The battery will not go flat between calibrations.

0.025 to 00.05	Reduced ability to see or locate moving lights correctly
	Reduced ability to judge distances
	Increased tendency to take risks

0.05	Twice as likely to have a crash as before you started drinking
0.05 to 0.08	Further reduction in your ability to judge distances
	Impaired sensitivity to red lights
	Slower reactions
	Shorter concentration span
0.08	Five times more likely to have a crash than before you started drinking
0.08 to 0.12	Overestimate abilities
	"Euphoria" sets in
	Impaired peripheral vision
	Impaired perception of obstacles
	Ten time more likely to have a crash
